## JEE Main 2020 Application Correction

For all the candidates registered successfully, the board will provide JEE Main Application correction facility to correct mistakes. It will be **one time facility** for the students to make corrections in the details of application form.

The application correction window will open in the first to last week of **October 2019** for the January session registration. For the April session, the correction process will start in the month of **February 2020**.

Students will be able to correct details in the application through **online mode** only. To make correction in the application, students have to pay an additional amount of **fee**.

Correction in the application must be done by the candidates before the last date of form submission.

## JEE Main 2020 Eligibility Criteria

### General Eligibility:

- **Qualifying Exam:** Applying candidate must have passed their **10+2 level** exams or its equivalent from a recognized board or university.
- **Diploma Holders:** Candidates who are holding diploma can also apply for admission but only in IITs.
- **Qualifying Subjects:** Candidate in their 12<sup>th</sup> level must have passed with at least of **five mandatory subjects** – Physics, Mathematics along with any one from the Biology, Chemistry, Biotechnology or any other technical vocational.
- **Age Criterion:** There is **no age limit** prescribed to apply for JEE Main 2020.
- **Total Attempts:** There will be no attempt limit to apply for this test.
- **Appearing Candidates:** Candidates who are appearing for their Class 12<sup>th</sup> exams can also apply.
- **Year of Appearance:** Candidates passing their 12<sup>th</sup> level exam in the year 2018 or 2019 are only eligible to apply. Also, those appearing in their 12<sup>th</sup> level in the year 2020 are also eligible to apply.

### Institutions wise Eligibility:

- To get admission into IITs, NITs, CFTIs and other institutions, students have secure **75%**(For ST/SC – 65%) marks in their 12<sup>th</sup> level exams.
- On the basis of All India Rank of the candidate secured in the test, admission will be provided.

## JEE Advanced 2020 Eligibility Criteria

It is the next step which the candidates have to ensure that they check. Aspirants must ensure that they check the eligibility criteria for JEE Advanced 2020 before moving on to the application form section. The application and the eligibility of the candidate will be rejected if it is found that the student is not eligible. Check the expected eligibility criteria for JEE Advanced 2020.

- **Performance in JEE Main 2020 Exam:** The student who wants to appear for JEE Advanced 2020 must be in the top 2,24,000 which includes all categories in Paper-1 of JEE (Main) 2020.
- **Age Limit:** The student should have been born on or after October 01, 1993. A relaxation of 5 years shall be given to the students belonging to SC, ST and PWD candidates.
- **Number of Attempts:** The student is eligible to appear for the exam for a maximum of 2 times in two consecutive years.
- **Appearance in Class 12th or equivalent Exam:** The aspirant should have appeared for the Class XII (or equivalent) examination for the first time in either 2019 or 2020.
- **Earlier Admission in IIT-** At the time of admission, the student should not have joined any program at any of IITs.

### NEET 2020 Application Form

Candidates can check the following details regarding NEET 2020 Application Form:

- Candidates will be able to fill NEET 2020 Application Form through **online** mode.
- You can fill one application form only. Filling of more than one application form will lead to cancellation of forms.
- The application form of NEET 2020 will be released from **2nd December 2019** by NTA.
- Last date to fill application form will be till **31st December 2019**.
- Candidates must provide working phone number and email Id at the time of registration to get login credentials.
- Candidates must submit recent **passport size photograph & signature** in the prescribed format to avoid rejection of images later.
- There is no need to send the printout of application form to the board.

### Application Fee:

The application fee payable for different categories is:

- General & OBC Category: Rs.1400/-

- SC/ST/PWD/Transgender Category: Rs.750/-
- Candidates will have to also pay additional charges & GST.

**Mode of Payment:** Candidates will be able to pay the Application Fee through online as well as offline mode. Credit Card/Debit Card/Net-banking are available as online mode. For offline mode, E-Challan facility is available at State Bank of India (SBI) branches.

### **NEET 2020 Eligibility Criteria**

Candidates must check the following NEET Eligibility Criteria before registering for exam:

- **Nationality:** Indian Nationals, Non Resident Indians (**NRIs**), Overseas Citizen of India (**OCI**), Persons with Indian origin (**PIO**) and Foreign Nationals citizen are eligible to apply for NEET (UG).
  - **Eligibility for 15% All India Quota Seats:** Candidates belonging to J&K states are eligible to apply under 15% All India Quotas only on the basis of self-declaration.
  - **Age limit:** Candidates must have completed minimum **17 years of age** on or before 31<sup>st</sup>December 2020. There is **no upper age limit** to apply.
  - **Qualification:** Candidates must have completed **12<sup>th</sup> level** or equivalent examination.
  - **Mandatory Subjects:** Students in their 12<sup>th</sup> level must have **Physics, Chemistry, and Biology/Biotechnology** with **English** as mandatory subject.
  - **Percentage:** Candidates in the 12<sup>th</sup> level must have secured minimum **50% marks** for General categories; **45% marks** for PH & **40% marks** for SC/ST/OBC category candidates in PCB group.
  - **Appearing:** Candidates are appearing in their qualifying exam or waiting for their result are also eligible for NEET (UG).

### AIIMS MBBS 2020 Application Form

Candidates must go through below details to know about AIIMS 2020 Application Form:

- AIIMS MBBS 2020 Application Form will be filled through **online mode**.
- The application process will commence from last week of **November 2019**.
- Candidates must fill complete details as incomplete application forms will get rejected.
- The Registration will be done according to **PAAR** facility which will consist of two stages – Basic registration and final registration.

- In the Basic registration, candidates have to fill their basic details & upload the images as per prescribed format.
- Candidates have to upload the scanned images of photograph, signature and left hand thumb impression.
- After completing basic registration, students whose registration will get accepted successfully have to further proceed for code generation step.
- In the final registration step, candidates are required to remaining details of form and make application fee payment.
- The official authority will provide the AIIMS MBBS correction facility through online mode.
- There will be no need to send any hard copy of application form via offline mode to the authority.
- Candidates are advised to keep the registration slip safely until the completion of admission procedure.

### Application Fee:

Candidates have to submit the application fee in final registration step.

**Mode of payment:** Application Fee can be paid through online gateway through credit card, debit card or net-banking.

### AIIMS 2020 Eligibility Criteria

Candidates must go through following details to know AIIMS Eligibility Criteria:

- **Nationality:** Indian Citizens, OCI and Foreign National candidates are eligible to apply.
- **Qualification:** Candidates must qualify **12<sup>th</sup> (10+2)** scheme/ SSC examination (CBSE) or Intermediate Science (I.SC.) or any equivalent examination.
- **Mandatory Subjects:** Candidates must have passed 12th with **Physics, Chemistry, and Biology** (PCB) with **English** as mandatory subjects.
- **Percentage:** Candidates must score minimum of **60% marks (50% for SC/ ST/ OPH & Foreign National)** category candidates.
- **Lower Age limit:** Candidates must be **17 years** in age as on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2020.
- **Upper Age limit:** There will be **no upper age limit** for AIIMS MBBS 2020.

## JIPMER 2020 Application Form

Check all the details related to [JIPMER 2020 Application Form](#) below:

- The Online registration process of JIPMER 2020 will start from the first week of **March 2020**.
- Before filling the application form, candidates must go through the complete eligibility criterion.
- Candidates have to keep certain details and **documents** ready before filling the application form like personal and academic details, scanned passport size photograph and signature, valid mobile number and email id etc.
- The Application process of JIPMER 2020 will be in various stages – Online Registration, filling the application form, **uploading of photograph and signature** and paying the application fee.

### **JIPMER 2020 Eligibility Criteria**

Check below the JIPMER 2020 [Eligibility criterion](#), before applying for the entrance exam:

#### **Nationality:**

- Applying candidate must be an Indian citizen.
- Overseas Citizens can also apply provided they have to submit **proof of registration** as OCI under the Section 7A of Citizenship Act 1955.
- Foreign National candidates have to take permission from Medical Council of India prior to applying.

#### **Qualification Criteria:**

- **Qualifying Examination:** Applying candidate must have passed his/her **10+2 level** exams or its equivalent from a recognized board or university.
- **Qualifying Subjects:** Candidates must have passed his/her qualifying exam with the subjects of **Physics, Biology/Biotechnology and Chemistry** including **English** as elective subject.
- **Qualifying Marks:** Candidates must have passed the qualifying exam with minimum of **50% marks** (For UR/General candidates) taken together in all subjects. For ST/SC/OBC and other reserved category, the qualifying marks are **40%** together in all subjects. For OPH-General candidates, the qualifying marks are **45%**.
- **Appearing Candidates:** Candidates are appearing for their 12<sup>th</sup> level exams are also eligible to apply.

#### **Age Criteria:**

- Applying candidate must have completed the age of **17 years** at the time of admission. No upper age limit is prescribed.
  - There is no age relaxation for candidates of reserved categories.

## **GBPUAT 2020 Application Form**

In this section, we will talk about the **GBPUAT 2020** application form:

- Candidates should carefully read the prospectus available on GB Pant University's official website.
- Candidates should ensure that they can apply.
- Students should apply for an online form that can be found on their official website.
- Students should complete all the information they need to apply for.
- The application fee should be paid by the candidate.
- Without paying the required application fee, no candidate will be registered.
- Candidates can choose e-challan for paying the application fee or opt for net banking or debit card payment.
- At the time of completion of the application form, candidates should provide a photographic image, signature image, and left thumb impression.
- The photograph's dimension is 200\* 230 pixels.
- 20 kb–50 kb should be the size.
- The student's signature should be.
- The candidate will be disqualified if at the time of the examination the signature provided in the application form fails to match.
- Should give an impression of the left thumb.
- Candidates should fill out the application form online, but should print it and submit it through the post.

- Fee receipt copy
- Category and weightage certificate
- Mark sheet of qualifying examination
- High school certificate
